MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (Oral)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.104 dated 04.10.2018, under Sections 341, 352, 427, 186, 353, 148, 149 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar, Sangrur.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on the previous date of hearing i.e. 14.11.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that initially, petitioner was found innocent by the police during investigation and now he has been summoned under the provisions of Section 190 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion for 13.12.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before learned trial Court. On his doing so, he shall be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing subject to the satisfaction of learned trial Court. ”

Contends that in terms of above order dated 14.11.2019, passed by this Court, petitioner has already joined the proceedings and released on bail by learned trial Court, vide order dated 21.11.2019.

 The aforesaid factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Krishan.

 In view of above, interim order dated 14.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

 It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and will not seek unnecessary adjournments.

 The above observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
