In view of request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, that urgency is involved in the matter, the case is taken up out of turn.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submits that application dated 11.10.2019 moved by the petitioner before Trial Court for summoning and preservation of the record i.e. call details and tower locations etc. of mobile phone numbers as described therein, is yet to be decided by the Trial Court. He further submits that matter has already been referred to Mediation Centre, Faridkot by the Trial Court. He further urges that preservation of call details and tower location details of mobile phones, as mentioned in the above said application, is of utmost importance for the decision of divorce petition.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that respondent No.1 has no objection, if the above said application, moved by the petitioner is disposed of by the Trial Court in accordance with law.

In view of above, instant civil revision petition is disposed of in the manner that the Trial Court shall make earnest and sincere efforts to dispose of application dated 11.10.2019, as detailed above, in accordance with law.
