Petitioner prays for grant of bail in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.171, dated 23.09.2019, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Maulijagran, Chandigarh.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner was found in conscious possession of 880 intoxicant tablets containing Tramadol salt.

Learned counsel for Union Territory, Chandigarh, on instructions from SI Sashi Kumar, has informed the Court that the petitioner is involved in 2 other cases under the NDPS Act.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner.
