The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.181 dated 28.07.2019, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is the outcome of a monetary dispute between the parties which has now been settled. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P2.

This Court, by the order dated 08.11.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the investigating/arresting officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the investigating/arresting officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Chirmal Singh states that the petitioner have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated

08.11.2019 granting ad interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
