The petitioner filed CRM-M-29419 of 2019 raising a grievance that the representation made to Superintendent of Police, Sirsa was not being considered. The petition was disposed of on 12.7.2019 directing the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to look into the matter after giving due hearing to the petitioner. The needful was to be done within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Learned counsel for the State submits that charge-sheet in the said case has been filed on 11.7.2019, however, order would be passed on the representation of the petitioner within three weeks from today.
