Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (*for short 'Cr.P.C.'*) for grant of bail, pending trial, to the petitioner in case FIR No.770 dated 20.09.2015, under Sections 302, 201, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned Counsel for the complainant has pointed out that only one prosecution witness remains to be examined and the next date before learned trial Court is 17.07.2019.

In view of above, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Permitted to do so.

Ordered accordingly.

However, learned trial Court is requested to examine the said

witness on the date fixed and conclude the proceedings expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Commissioner of Police, Gurugram shall ensure that the said prosecution witness be produced on the date fixed before learned trial Court.
