The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.PC for grant of interim regular bail for 5 days pending trial in case bearing FIR No.4 dated 03.01.2019 under Sections 306 and 376 IPC registered at Police Station Yamuna Nagar City, District Yamuna Nagar so as to attend the marriage of his real brother scheduled to be solemnised on 10.11.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2019 and the deceased had died because of hanging. The petitioner and the deceased were in love affairs for the last about 2 years, but she committed suicide by hanging at the place where the petitioner is working i.e. Public Health Department, Yamuna Nagar.

He further submits that the petitioner had brought the deceased to the hospital along with other co-employees. The petitioner has confined his prayer for interim bail so as to attend the marriage of his real brother fixed for 10.11.2019.

Notice of motion was issued in this case for today.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Parmod Kumar, does not dispute the factum of marriage of Harpreet Singh, who is real brother of the petitioner. It is submitted that there is no other case against the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2019 and the marriage of his real brother is fixed for 10.11.2019, the petitioner is admitted on interim bail for a period of five days subject to his furnishing bail bonds and heavy surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities on or before 13.11.2019 till 05.00 P.M.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
