The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.265 dated 30.08.2019 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 18.11.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, petitioner Satnam Singh @ Lovepreet @ Pandi along with Joban Singh attacked the complainant with baseball bat and caused injuries on his head. It is further submitted that there is no specific attribution to any of the accused person, as to who has caused injury No.4, which was declared grievous. Learned counsel further submits that even subsequently, no supplementary statement was recorded to explain this fact.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, could not dispute the factual position.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the order dated 18.11.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurbir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 18.11.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
