On 13.11.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 172 dated 13.10.2019 registered under Section 382 IPC at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda.

As per the allegations, petitioner is alleged to have snatched a multi Axle vehicle from the first informant.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner draws attention of the Court to the affidavit of first informant-complainant acknowledging the sale of half share in the multi Axle vehicle to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. S.P.S.Tinna, Addl. AG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 29.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhola Singh has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 13.11.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
