Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.80 dated 13.08.2019 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 08.11.2019: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner along with Gurcharan Kaur had purchased the land from the co-accused Jasbir Singh and Sarabjit Singh after verifying the revenue records regarding the sale and later on, the land was sold to one Piar Kaur. It is further submitted that the co-accused Piar Kaur and Jaspal Singh as well as Gurcharan Kaur have already

been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 04.10.2019 passed in CRM-M No.42589 of 2019 as well as the order dated 04.11.2019 passed in CRM-M No.46911 of 2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
