The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 44, dated 13.03.2019, under Sections 379-B (Section 411 IPC added vide DDR No.35 dated 02.05.2019) of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur .

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with co-accused had snatched the ear rings of the complainant. The petitioner is 24 years old and not involved in any other case. He is in custody for over 09 months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Gurmeet Singh states that 01 out of 08 prosecution witness has been examined so far.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is not involved in any other case, he is in

custody for over 09 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
