Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.100 dated 05.06.2019 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 30.07.2019; he is first offender and is not involved in any other case. It is further submitted that the petitioner was nominated in the FIR on the basis of statement of the complainant and even the alleged injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 14.11.2019 in the Court today and submitted that challan stands presented before the trial Court.

A perusal of the custody certificate shows that the petitioner is in

custody for the last 03 months and 15 days and is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody for the last more than three months; he is not involved in any other case and the injury attributed to him is found to be simple in nature, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
