The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.08 dated 11.01.2018 under Section 25 of Arms Act and Sections 186, 307, 34, 353 IPC, registered at Police Station Gohana Sadar, District Sonapat.

On 13.11.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted the regular bail and was facing the trial, however, he absented from the Court proceedings on 27.08.2019 due to miscommunication and his bail/surety bonds were forfeited. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and face the trial. A perusal of the orders passed by the trial Court shows that the case is now fixed for recording the prosecution evidence and the trial is being delayed on account of non-appearance of the petitioner. Notice of motion for 19.12.2019. In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and the trial Court will release him on interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety

bonds and on payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Sonapat.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 13.11.2019, has already appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on interim bail and he has also deposited the costs of Rs. 10,000/- as imposed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Naresh Kumar[, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 13.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
