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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in case FIR No. 396, dated 6.11.2018, registered under Sections 379-A/34, 411 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Jind. The case was registered on the complaint of one Rishi son of Surender.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner is in custody since 21.11.2018. The complainant has already been examined and he has not even identified the petitioner. It is further stated that the alleged incident is dated 27.10.2018 whereas FIR was lodged on 6.11.2018 i.e. after a delay of 10 days.

The learned State counsel, opposing the bail application, has pointed out that there are various cases of similar nature pending against the petitioner.

Be that as it may, the fact that complainant has been examined and he has not identified the petitioner in Court has not been disputed and considering that trial may take a long time to conclude, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of present case, without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
