Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.562, dated 04.09.2018, registered under Section 408 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Palam Vihar, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is not Manpreet Singh, who had committed the crime.

On 15.11.2019, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, had submitted that it is the petitioner (Inderjit Singh son of Amrik Singh) who had, in fact, impersonated as Manpreet Singh and fled away with the car in question. It has also been brought to the notice of the court that the petitioner is involved in two more criminal cases.

Keeping in view the different stands taken by counsel for the petitioner and the State, affidavit was directed to be filed.

Today affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police along with print of CCTV footage, Aadhar Card of the petitioner and his photographs has been filed in Court, which is taken on record.

Keeping in view the aforesaid affidavit and the facts which have come on record and without commenting on the merits, this court is not inclined to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
