Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in criminal case arising from FIR No.0091 dated 12.04.2018 registered under Sections 365 IPC and Sections 302, 201, 34 of IPC added later on at Police Station Maloya, UT Chandigarh.

As per case of the prosecution, Mohammad Ali has been murdered by the petitioner by strangulation.

Learned counsel appearing for the Union Territory has submitted that the shirt worn by the petitioner-accused at the time of occurrence was taken in possession on his disclosure statement and the blood strains have been got examined from the Central Forensic Science Laboratory prove presence of human blood.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
