1. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 and 2 only.
2. Mr. R.S. Hooda, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 and states that the writ petition is premature as the claim of the petitioner has been returned by respondent Nos.1 and 2 on account of failure of respondent No.3 to deposit EPF dues for the year 2010-2011 and 2011-2012 and that in the circumstances, the remedy available to the petitioner is to move an application before the Controlling Authority i.e. Commissioner Provident Fund, Karnal under Section 7-A of the Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.
3. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
