RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

Petitioner is on parole. His parole period is due to expire on 23.11.2019. This is a petition for extension of parole on the ground that the petitioner's wife is in the family way and is expected to deliver a child on 05.01.2020.

I deem it inappropriate to extend the parole to cover the period 05.01.2020 and beyond, therefore, the request is declined but with the liberty to the petitioner to move an application at an appropriate stage in advance of the due date, and in case such application is made, the authorities are directed to take up the same on priority basis and decide the request within the shortest possible time after verifying the facts and of the condition of the family as to whether the petitioner is the only one, who is available to attend to his wife. With this direction, this petition is disposed of.

This Court trusts, that in case an application is filed at any time, it will be decided in a few days, keeping in mind the arrival of child, leaving sufficient margin for the actual date of birth.
