The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 79 dated 30.08.2019, under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Valtaha, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had received excess compensation for the fencing of his land at the Indo-Pak border. He states that the compensation which had been received by the petitioner in excess has been quantified at Rs.1,27,064/-. The petitioner is in custody for over 2 ½ months .

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Tejinder Singh, states that the investigation could not be completed as five co-accused are to be arrested in the case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner

especially when the petitioner is in custody for over two and a half months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
