Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner on the post of JCB Driver w.e.f 01.10.2003 in terms of Policy Annexure P-6 dated 29.07.2011.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioner has submitted representations Annexure P-5 and P-8 dated 29.11.2015 and 18.09.2017 respectively but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.4/competent Authority to consider and decide the representations Annexure P-5 and P-8 dated 29.11.2015 and 18.09.2017 respectively in accordance with law as well as decision of a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.2009 of 2016 in case titled as **Balwinder Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others** decided on 04.10.2018.

3. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.4/competent Authority to consider and decide the representations Annexure P-5 and P-8 dated 29.11.2015 and 18.09.2017 respectively in accordance with the rules/regulations/instructions applicable as well as decision of this Court in CWP No.2009 of 2016 in case titled as Balwinder Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others in case the same is applicable within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order

4. Writ petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
