The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 12.07.2018, vide which a direction was issued to decide the legal notice and take a conscious decision.

Learned State counsel has placed on record order dated 22.01.2019, vide which claim of the petitioner towards ACP of 8, 16, 24 and 32 has been granted.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however states that neither interest has been paid nor the said question with respect to the interest has been decided by the respondent.

In view of the same, respondent is directed to take decision with respect to the interest on the said amount within four weeks from today. If the petitioner is found entitled to the said interest, the same too shall be paid to the petitioner, otherwise a speaking order shall be passed and the copy of the said speaking order shall be supplied to the petitioner.

The petitioner is also at liberty to challenge the said speaking order, in accordance with law, if so aggrieved.
