The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 282 dated 22.09.2019 registered under Section 22/29, Act No. 61 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (**NDPS**) Act, 1985, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FSL report has not yet been received.

The custody certificate by way of affidavit of Gurpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent Maximum Security Jail, Nabha, filed by the learned State counsel in the Court today, is taken on record.

On the instructions from ASI Kirpal Singh, learned State counsel

has brought to the notice of this Court that FSL report is still awaited.

Without commenting anything on the merits lest, it should prejudice the case either side, the petitioner is granted interim bail, subject to furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned, till the receipt of FSL report. On receipt of FSL report, the petitioner would surrender before the learned trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
