The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 1124 dated 09.08.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioner was arrested on 10.07.2019 and since then he is in custody, challan has been presented and charge-sheet has been framed.

On the instructions from ASI Ramesh Chand, learned State counsel stated that till date out of total 9 witnesses, no witness has examined.

At this stage, Mr. Naresh Kumar Chhokar, Advocate, has appeared and filed Vakalatnama on behalf of the complainant, which is taken on record. He stated that even the cheques were issued by the petitioner and

proceedings under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and under Section 420 of IPC are initiated against the petitioner.

In view of the facts that challan has been presented and charges have been framed and prosecution will taken time, without commenting anything on the merits lest, it should prejudice the case either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
