Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.173 dated 30.08.2005, under Sections 452, 379, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 427 and 411, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on the previous date of hearing i.e. 13.11.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that the petitioner is ready to join proceedings before the learned trial Court.

Notice of motion returnable on 18.12.2019.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join proceedings before learned trial Court and he be released on interim bail, till the next date of hearing, subject to its satisfaction. ”

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has produced the copy of order dated 16.11.2019, passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala, which indicates that in terms of above order dated 13.11.2019, passed by this Court, petitioner has already joined the proceedings and released on bail. The same is taken on record.

The aforesaid factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Baldev Raj.

In view of above, interim order dated 13.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and will not seek unnecessary adjournments.

The above observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
