Learned State counsel submits that the case before the trial Court is fixed for 19.09.2019 for the remaining prosecution evidence. He states that as against 21 witnesses, 16 have already been examined and efforts would be made to examine the left over witnesses.

Considering the advance stage of the trial when substantial number of prosecution witnesses have been examined, counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition at this stage. However, he states that a direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the evidence on the next date of hearing, failing which liberty may be granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application for the relief claimed in the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

The prosecution shall make an endeavour to conclude the

evidence on the next date of hearing i.e.19.09.2019 . However, in case the

witnesses are not examined, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for regular bail before the trial Court.
