Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.48, dated 27.03.2019, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Mehta District Amritsar.

As per the case of the prosecution, initially the petitioner was found in conscious possession of 5 gram heroin which falls in small quantity. However, on his disclosure statement on the next day while he was in police custody, 1 Kg and 600 gram heroin was recovered near India-Pakistan International Border from the fields of Harpal Singh.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh, has also submitted that one SIM of a mobile phone of Pakistan origin has also been recovered from the petitioner.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, this court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in

custody, learned Special Court is requested to make sincere efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously.
