HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J

The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with a prayer that her husband served the respondent(s)/Department as Mali-Cum-Beldar starting from the year 1995 till the date on which he unfortunately died i.e. on 17.05.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that even though the husband of the petitioner was entitled for regularization, as the persons juniors to the husband of the petitioner had already been regularized, the petitioner becomes entitled for the grant of benefit by treating the late husband of the petitioner as a regular employee.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondent(s) with a legal notice dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.
