Ms. Deepali Puri, Advocate, entered appearance on behalf of
respondent Nos.6 and 7 and filed her memorandum of appearance. Same is
taken on record.

This writ petition was filed by the petitioners aggrieved by the
alleged inaction on the part of the authorities in not registering the second
petitioner-firm as a rice mill for the purpose of custom milling under the
Custom Milling Policy (Kharif 2019-20) (for short, 'the policy').

While so, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, learned Assistant Advocate

General, Punjab, would inform this Court that the application submitted by

the second petitioner-firm was considered on its own merits and by order dated 15.11.2019, the Director, Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Punjab, Chandigarh, rejected the claim of the second petitioner-firm for registration under the policy. Copy of the said order is placed on record. A copy thereof is furnished to Mr. Daman Dhir, learned counsel for the petitioners.

In the light of the aforestated development which took place after the institution of this case, the cause in this writ petition no longer survives for consideration on merits. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of leaving it open to the petitioners to take recourse to appropriate remedies available to them in accordance with law, if they have any grievance with the order dated 15.11.2019.
