Heard learned counsels for the parties.

The dispute between the parties is arising out of a business transactions between 3 different companies. The proceedings before the National Company Law Tribunal are pending.

On 15.11.2019, following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and seeks time to get instructions.

Mr. Vinod Ghai, Senior Advocate, assisted by Mr. Akshay Dhawan, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the first informant.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and first informant at length.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, petitioner is directed to join the investigation.

Adjourned to 22.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released

on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Reply to the petition, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurjeet Singh, who is present in the Court, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation. Co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted concession of regular bail by the Magistrate after passing a detailed order.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, the interim order dated 15.11.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
