GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No.101 dated 05.06.2019 under Sections 341/506 of IPC and Sections 8 & 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Women, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.
2. The FIR was registered at the instance of the victim, where it has been alleged that she is a student aged about 17 years and that the petitioner, who resides in the neighbourhood had been harassing her in an inappropriate manner and stalks her and had threatened her that in case she disclosed anything to her family, he would kill her. It has further alleged therein that on 15.05.2019, when she came out in the street, then the petitioner caught hold of her hand and teased her.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that a false FIR has been registered against him and that in any case, since challan already stands presented, his further detention is not required.

4. Opposing the petition, learned State counsel has submitted that since the petitioner is specifically named in the FIR and till date, six out of the cited nine PWs stand examined, no case for grant of bail is made out.
5. Having considered rival submissions addressed before this Court and bearing in mind the nature of allegations and the fact that the petitioner has behind the bars for more than 5 months, further detention of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose. The petition, as such, is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Illaqa Magistrate concerned.
