The petitioner prays for concession of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.0263 dated 27.05.2019, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324 and 452 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Sonipat City, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and therefore, the petitioner is not alleged to have inflicted any injury to the injured. He further submits that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Mohit has been granted concession of pre-arrest bail and role of the petitioner as well as Mohit is similar.

Learned State counsel has not disputed this fact.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and after keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, it would be appropriate to direct the release of petitioner on regular bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
