The petitioner filed a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to the respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents. In the said petition, a request was made by learned counsel for the petitioner that he would be satisfied in case Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, is directed to look into the representation.

The petition was disposed of on 26.2.2019 directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, to look into the representation and do the needful if required. Compliance was to be done within two months from receipt of the certified copy of order.

The present petition has been filed pleading that the respondent has not done the needful.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced communication dated 6.12.2019 whereby it has been stated that representation Annexure-P4 (with the criminal petition) was never received by the SSP's office.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to substantiate that the said representation was ever given in the SSP office.

In view of above, no case is made out for wilful disobedience of order to this Court.

Dismissed.

In case, the petitioner files a representation within one week, the respondent shall consider the same within two months thereafter.
