Report dated 23.01.2019 of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ferozepur has been received whereby after recording statements of respondents Rajesh Kumar and Jiwan Bala and accused/petitioners Deepak Kapoor @ Deepu, Rohit Kapoor @ Sunny, Rahul Kapoor @ Love, Sanjeev Kapoor @ Monu and Sagar @ Billa the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, the private parties to this petition have put in appearance before this Court and during the course of interaction with the parties, it transpired that they have compromised the

matter and resolved to end the dispute and compromised the matter as per compromise/settlement (Annexure P-3) and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

In the light of statements made by the parties and the fact that the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 116 dated 27.05.2016 registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur under Sections 452, 354, 323, 506, 148 and 149 and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
