Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents not to replace the petitioners who were appointed as contractual employees under the Outsourcing Policy 2015 by another set of contractual employees till regular selection is made against posts in question as also for grant of relief with regard to minimum pay and allowances at par with what is being paid to the regular set of employees.

2.           After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file a comprehensive representation before respondent No.2 in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the instant writ petition and direction being issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation on receipt in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to submit a comprehensive representation. In case any representation is submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2 on receipt of certified copy of this order, the same be considered and decided in accordance with law within four weeks thereafter.
