Seen the clarification sent up by the Ld. Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Gurdaspur, vide his Letter No.233, dated 12.03.2019, from which it transpires that he is also vested with the power to try civil cases and that the nomenclature "Chief Judicial Magistrate" was typed by inadvertence at the bottom of the order.

2. The explanation submitted by the Ld. Presiding Officer is satisfactory.

3. On merits, this Court finds no reason to interfere with the impugned order. If anything, the maintenance granted in favour of the respondent appears to be rather on the lower side.
