Prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.55 dated 19.08.2019 under Section 384 IPC and Sections 7 & 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act registered at P.S Amir Khas, District Fazilka.

The FIR was got registered on the basis of conversation, which was posted at social media through a mobile phone. The petitioner was recorded of having received a sum of Rs.10,000/- from Pasho Bai and co-accused Gurjant Singh is alleged to have taken Rs.10,000/- from Bimla Rani as bribe in order to weaken their cases registered under the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no sanction for prosecution of the petitioner was ever obtained and that no bribe was received by the petitioner and that the false recovery has been planted on him.

Opposing the petition, the learned State counsel has submitted that the investigation in this case is complete and that the petitioner is in custody since 19.08.2019.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and

19.08.2019 and is not wanted in any other case, in my opinion, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner behind bars any further. The petition, as such, is accepted. The petitioner Om parkash is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned of trial Court/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, in case the petitioner indulges in any activity akin to one for which he has been convicted, while on bail, the prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek the cancellation of the order granting bail to the petitioner.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
