The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 224 dated 18.07.2018 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 18.07.2018. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as no PW has been examined till date. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and, thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
