The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.34 dated 5.7.2018, registered at Police Station Anaj Mandi, Patiala, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Custody certificate dated 31.1.2019, prepared by Sh. GS Dhaliwal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent, Central Prison, Patiala, has been filed in Court and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, there are 07 other cases pending against the petitioner and one conviction has been recorded.

Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioner seeks grant of interim bail on account of expected delivery of his wife. It is stated that the wife of the petitioner is due to deliver on 19.2.2019 and thus, interim bail be granted to him for a period of 30 days.

The request appears to be genuine. Consequently, this petition for grant of regular bail is treated as one for grant of interim bail. It is directed that the petitioner be released on interim bail for a period of 30 days starting from 4.2.2019 to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned. He

shall surrender before the jail authorities concerned on 7.3.2019 by 12.00 noon.
