Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 116 dated 04.06.2018 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged recovery has been effected from the house which was taken on rent by one Gurdeep Singh. The premises does not belong to the petitioner and no recovery was effected from him and the petitioner is in custody since

On the instructions from ASI Kewal Singh, Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that out of nine witnesses, only three witnesses have been examined. The trial would take time to conclude.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
