On 14.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail  
in a criminal case arising out from FIR No. 274, dated  
11.10.2019, registered under Sections 406/420/120-B  
IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while  
referring to the FIR submits that after the parties once  
settled the dispute but thereafter resiled therefrom. The  
petitioner was sought to be named as a prosecution  
witness. He submits that the petitioner is neither signatory  
to the compromise nor employee of company-One Way  
Skill Management & Technology Private Limited.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra,

Addl. A.G.,Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. A.G.,Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nachhatar Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 14.11.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
