Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr.P.C.') in FIR No.409 dated 27.07.2018, for offence punishable under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner was running a business of committee (chit) and has taken certain amounts from the complainant. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since 28.09.2018; challan stands presented and the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted the concession of regular bail. It is also submitted that the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and it will take long time in conclusion of the trial.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Anil Kumar, assisted by counsel for the complainant has, however, submitted that some other complaints are also pending against the petitioner.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody for the last 09 months as per the Custody Certificate filed in the Court today and also in view of the fact that the investigation is complete and the conclusion of the trial will take some time, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail of the petitioner, in case he is found involved in any other case or misusing the concession of bail, in any manner.
