Pursuant to the order dated 18.11.2019, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, who is present in Court to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required presently.

In view of the above, the order dated 18.11.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, the aforesaid order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

Naturally, the complainant would be at liberty to avail of his remedy as regards any grievance, including the investigation process.
