The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 read with Section 483 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondent No.1-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Balachaur, District SBS Nagar to dispose of the complaint No.360 dated 26.01.2017 (CNR No.PBSBA/000360/2017 titled as Varinder Kumar Vs. Jaswant Singh and others filed under Sections 499, 500 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860) pending in his Court.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner examined three witnesses and closed his preliminary evidence on 05.12.2017 and since then the case is pending for arguments and adjournments are being repeatedly given. Learned Counsel for the petitioner has prayed that respondent No.1 may be directed to dispose of the said complaint.

In view of the nature of relief sought and the order proposed to be passed, issuance of notice to the respondents is considered to be unnecessary.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case but without commenting on the merits in any manner, the petition is allowed and respondent No.1 is directed to hear arguments and pass appropriate orders in the complaint expeditiously preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
