This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.56 dated 07.03.2013 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, P.S. City Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 25.02.2019 by way of affidavit of Iqbal Singh Dhaliwal, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana is taken on record. As per the same, the petitioner has undergone 03 months and 28 days of custody as on 25.02.2019.

As per the allegations, the petitioner impersonated as owner of a plot and entered into an agreement to sell with the complainant and received the earnest money of Rs.6 lakhs.

Counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has already

undergone almost 4 months of custody and the trial is not likely to conclude in near future.

Learned Deputy Advocate General has accepted the factum of custody.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
