By way of instant petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to conclude the pending enquiry by taking into consideration his representation dated 14.10.2019 (Annexure P-3), as he is going to retire on 31.03.2020.

objectively consider the representation dated 14.10.2019 (Annexure P-3) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and decide the pending enquiry proceedings expeditiously.
