[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been granted increments of pay vide Order (Annexure P-7) dated 16.11.2018 and is to be paid arrears w.e.f. July, 2017 as per the basic pay fixation recorded in Annexure P-7, but no action has been taken to make payment of arrears to the petitioner, till date.

[2] Learned counsel states that he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition at this stage with liberty to file a representation for the relief claimed for in the writ petition and directions be issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation on receipt thereof.

[3] Without commenting on the merits of the claim and in view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation within 02 weeks from today. On receipt of the representation, respondent No.2 shall consider and decide the same, in accordance with law within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order along with representation.
