Challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 29.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Central Board of Secondary Education declining the request of the petitioner as regards correction of his father's name in the matriculation certificate.

During the course of arguments, it stands conceded by counsel that the correction as sought for by the petitioner has not been incorporated as of date in the school records.

Under such circumstances, no infirmity is found in the order of rejection passed by the CBSE.

No basis for interference as such is made out.

Petition is dismissed.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to approach the CBSE afresh seeking the necessary correction after getting the school records updated.
