Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.109 dated 22.07.2017, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Nihalsingh Wala, District Moga.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 19.12.2018:-

“Contends that learned counsel representing the petitioner before the learned trial Court noted a wrong date and due to that reason could not appear and as a result of which order dated 06.12.2018 has been passed whereby the bail bonds/surety bonds of the petitioner were cancelled. Further contends that the petitioner is still ready to join the proceedings before the learned trial Court.

Notice of motion for 29.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join

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the proceedings before the learned trial Court and in case of doing so, he will be released on interim bail on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of the order dated 19.12.2018, the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the learned trial Court and has been granted interim bail. He has also produced a copy of the order dated 03.01.2019, same is retained on file as mark X.

In view of above, the interim order dated 19.12.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

However, it is, made clear that the petitioner will fully cooperate with the proceedings before the learned trial Court and shall not seek any unnecessary adjournment.
