AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 21.08.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.20928 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“As the relief claimed in the writ petition is to the limited extent that representation dated 15.04.2018 (Annexure P6) be considered by the respondents, present writ petition stands disposed of with the direction to the respondents to consider the above said representation and take required action thereon, if any, as per law.”

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that only issue survives is with regard to payment of interest on delayed payment of gratuity.

Learned counsel for the State fairly submits that while passing order dated 02.09.2019, the issue with regard to interest has not been adjudicated. He states that the said issue would be decided within six weeks from today after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, the contempt petition is disposed of.

Only in the eventuality of not passing of order within six weeks from today, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
