Petitioner-Sandeep Singh has filed this 4th petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No. 295 dated 08.6.2018, under Section 22-B of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad. The petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 08.6.2018.

As per prosecution, on 08.6.2018, police party was present in front of Nagpur police post for the purpose of barricading. They saw a motor-cycle coming from the side of Ratia and they signalled to stop the same. Then the driver of the motor-cycle suddenly turned the same and tried to fled away. But he was apprehended by the police. On search, out

of the polythene of white colour, which the petitioner was carrying on his motor-cycle, 40 strips of intoxicant tablets Tramadol Hydrochloride and Domperidone, totaling 400 tablets were recovered.

On specific query put by the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that this is the 4th petition filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail and the previous petitions were ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn on 23.8.2018, 06.12.2018 and 24.7.2019. He has no material to show any changed circumstances giving cause of action for filing the present petition.

In view of the above, no ground for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
